INFORMATION

Information pertaining to registration of alarms can be found in Article 731 of the City of Easton Ordinances. Additionally, Section 7511 (c) (1) of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code states as follows:

“False alarms prohibited - A person that owns, uses or possesses an alarm device or automatic dialing device may not, after causing or permitting three (3) false alarms in a consecutive 12-month period, cause or permit a subsequent false alarm to occur in the same consecutive 12-month period. A person that violates this paragraph commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$300.”

Further - *“Registration of an alarm system is not intended to, or will it, create a contract, duty or obligation, either expressed or implied, of response. Any and all liability and consequential damage resulting from the failure to respond to notification is hereby disclaimed and governmental immunity as provided by law is retained. By registering an alarm system, the alarm user acknowledges that police response may be based on factors such as: availability of police units, priority of calls, weather conditions, emergency conditions, traffic conditions, and staffing.”* (NBFAA/FARA Model Burglar Alarm Ordinance)
