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Enacted by Council:

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AN ORDINANCE: Amending Sections in Chapter 376, Noise, of the Code of the City of Easton, Pa.

THE CITY OF EASTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 376-2 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 376-2. Powers and duties of Police Department, ~~and Bureau of Code Enforcement~~ and Lafayette College Police Officers.

SECTION 2. Section 376-2 A, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The noise control program established by this chapter shall be administered by the Easton Police Department, ~~and Bureau of Code Enforcement~~ and Lafayette College Police Officers.

SECTION 3. Section 376-2 C, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. The Easton Police Department and Lafayette College Police Officers shall have the power to investigate suspected violations and enforce 376-3.

SECTION 4. Section 376-3 B, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Enforcement . The Easton Police Department and or Lafayette College Police Officers shall have primary responsibility for the enforcement of prohibited acts under 376-3.

SECTION 5. Section 376-4 A, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The Zoning Hearing Board shall serve as the appeal board for the resolution of differences between the Easton Police Department, ~~and/or Bureau of Code Enforcement~~ and/or the Lafayette College Police Officers and persons aggrieved by the application of this chapter, pursuant to the same terms, compensation and rules as are

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AN ORDINANCE: Amending Sections in Chapter 410, Peace and Good Order, of the Code of the City of Easton, Pa.

THE CITY OF EASTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Sections 410-2, (5), (a), (b), (d) and (f) be and they are hereby repealed in their entirety.

- (a) ~~The flight of a person upon the appearance of a peace officer or any other person.~~
- (b) ~~Attempted concealment by a person upon the appearance of a peace officer or any other person.~~
- (d) ~~Repeated activity by a person, continuous or broken, which outwardly manifests no purpose, such as going from one place to another and back with no showing of use for such movement.~~
- (f) ~~A change in direction by a person upon the appearance of a peace officer and in order to avoid meeting or crossing paths with such officer.~~

SECTION 2. Section 410-4 be and it is hereby added and shall read as follows:

4. Enforcement. Enforcement of this chapter shall be conducted by the Easton Police Department, Pennsylvania State Police and/or Lafayette College Police.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days following adoption by Council.
