Install and provide total maintenance to one (1) Company-owned, 150-watt, high pressure sodium vapor, cobrahead street light at the intersection of 10th and Willow Streets, on existing wood pole 70071-50499, within the City.

Payment to be made to Met-Ed for the additional lighting at the rates specified in the Tariff.
