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Enacted by Council:

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AN ORDINANCE: Amending Section 285-29, Fees - Vehicles and Traffic, Chapter 560 of the Code of the City of Easton

THE CITY OF EASTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 285-29 B (3) and (4) be and they are hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) Parking meter zone rates (§ 560-58)

See Chapter 560-58 meter zones – TABLE 1(a)

(4) City Parking Facilities

(a) Parking meter rates per hour (§ 560-72), Parking meters are established and authorized upon certain off-street lots in the City as follows:

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days following adoption by Council.

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Enacted by Council:

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AN ORDINANCE: Amending Sections in Chapter 560, Vehicles and Traffic of the Code of the City of Easton, Pa.

THE CITY OF EASTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 560-9 be and it is hereby amended by adding the following at the end of the paragraph:

as required by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code Title 75, Chapter 37, Sub Chapter C, Accident and Accident Reports.

SECTION 2. Section 560-11 A be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. The City Council, under the following conditions, shall designate no more than 4 (four) towing companies as approved, and garages as approved storage places for the storage of Impounded motor vehicles that meet the following conditions.

SECTION 3. Section 560-11 F, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

- F. Each approved towing company, during its regular period of on-call rotation, shall be the sole towing agency during such period, unless
- 1). Said towing company requests another agency be called in its place.
 - 2). The on call tow service fails to respond to the request for service within a reasonable timeframe. Expected response time shall be no more than 15 (fifteen) minutes from initial contact with the tow company and a max response time of no more than 30 (thirty) minutes from initial contact with the tow company. If the max time is exceeded the Police Supervisor may request the next tow service on the scheduled rotation to respond.
 - 3.) The Police Supervisor may request, at his/her discretion, an alternate tow service than that scheduled per the on call rotation if circumstances necessitate the need for specific equipment or multiple tow units not available by the tow service on call.

Nothing in this section shall prohibit any authorized tow service from subcontracting

to another tow service or requesting assistance from another tow service.

SECTION 4. Section 560-15, be and it is hereby amended by deleting the following and adding the following at the end of the paragraph:

Delete: the Chief of Police in emergency situations as aforementioned.

Add: at the tower's or salvager's request or at the request of the Police Supervisor for reason aforementioned in Section 560-11.

SECTION 5. Section 560-56 I, be and it is hereby amended by deleting the word "Sanitarian" from the sub-section and replacing it with the words "Health Officer."

SECTION 6. Section 560-57 be and it is hereby amended by adding the following:

F. The City Administration reserves the right to create and enforce handicap and 12-minute metered spaces as needed in designated metered areas.

SECTION 7. Section 560-58 be and it is hereby amended to read as per Exhibit "A"

SECTION 8. Section 560-59 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Parking meters shall be operated by the deposit of a coin in the meter, as prescribed by §560-61 of this article, and the parking rates for specified lengths of time, as well as maximum parking times prescribed in §560-58 of this article shall apply at all times as set forth in Section 560-58 Table 1(a).

SECTION 9. Section 560-60 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Parking meters installed in the parking meter zones established by §560-58 of this article shall be placed upon the curb or sidewalk and immediately adjacent to the individual parking spaces described in §560-61 of this article. Each parking meter shall be placed or set so as to show that the parking space adjacent o that meter is or is not legally occupied. Each parking meter installed shall indicate by a proper legend the legal parking time established by the City, and when the adjacent space is occupied by a vehicle, the parking meter shall indicate on and by its display the duration of the period of legal parking and, on the expiration of that period, shall indicate illegal parking or over parking.

SECTION 10. Section 56-64 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful and a violation of this article for any person to deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter installed under the provisions of this article any coin for the purpose of increasing or extending the parking time of any vehicle beyond the maximum legal parking limit as set forth in Section 56-58 Table I(a).

SECTION 11. Section 560-82, be and it is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 12. Section 560-86 B, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:
