BILL NO. 3, Amending Section 285-45, Recreation registration, and Section 285-56, Pool Fees, B, Season pass, (1) and (2) and eliminating Section 285-47, Sports Fees, of Chapter 285, Fees of the Code of the City of Easton, Pa.

SECTION 1. Section 285-45, Recreation registration be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

(OLD)

- A. ~~Recreation registration fee: \$20 per participant.~~
- B. ~~Families with three or more children registering to participate for the same sports season do not pay for the fourth or more children.~~

(NEW)

- A. Sport registration fee is \$40 per child.
- B. The City of Easton Bureau of Recreation will provide each participant with a uniform.
- C. Protective/safety equipment will be provided when necessary.
- D. Registrants 13 years and older will be required herein to return city-issued uniforms in laundered and satisfactory condition within 7 calendar days of the completion of their sports season. The City may take action to limit or prohibit the participation of the registrant and/or immediate family members in City youth sports if uniforms and equipment are not returned in satisfactory condition or if appropriate payment is not made for any damages to same.

SECTION 2. Section 285-47, Sports fees, be and it is hereby repealed in its entirety.

- A. ~~Sports registration fee, per child \$25~~
- B. ~~Refundable uniform deposit, per uniform: \$20~~
- C. ~~Under 12 Baseball and Softball: uniform to be paid in full by registrant to City at the City's cost.~~

SECTION 3. Section 285-56 B (1) be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~(1) June 1 or before, 2010~~

(1) Before June 2

SECTION 4. Section 285-56 B (2) be and it is hereby amended to read as follows

~~(2) June 2 and after, 2010~~

(2) After June 2

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days following adoption by Council.
