

EASTON DOWNTOWN/ COURTHOUSE AREAS PARKING STUDY

The Easton Parking Authority and City of Easton are undertaking a parking study of the downtown and area immediately around the Northampton County Courthouse to better understand use and needs, and craft a strategic parking management plan to support our community and continued development. The study kicks off September 27, 2011 and is anticipated to be complete by the end of the year.



PROJECT SCOPE

The Courthouse and Downtown communities have varied and complicated needs based on the diversity of uses within each neighborhood. From residential to commercial needs, regional and national destinations to our going festivals and event, understanding our parking needs and the relationships between each is very important and requires professional expertise. The Easton Parking Authority, in partnership with the City of Easton, has contracted with DESMAN Associates after an open, public professional services bidding process. DESMAN Associates will conduct a series of stakeholder roundtables, public meetings, traffic and parking counts, and analyze future development scenarios to gather information and make recommendations on the future of parking in the Downtown and Courthouse neighborhoods.



YOU ARE A KEY LEADER

The Downtown and Courthouse Areas Parking Study is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2011. To facilitate this we are kicking-off the study on September 27-28th, 2011 with a Public Meeting. It is critical that you participate in this initial information gathering meeting so that DESMAN Associates understands how we operate and what we see are primary parking concerns.
