Please locate your residential area on this map.


Colors indicate which day of the week your pickup of trash and WEEKLY recycling will be.



Holiday Schedule:

If one of the holidays falls on your pickup day, then your pickup day with **ALL REMAINING COLLECTIONS THAT WEEK** will be one day later.

New Year's Day (Jan. 1)	Jan. 2
Memorial Day (May 30)	May 31
Independence Day (July 4)	July 5
Labor Day (Sept. 5)	Sept. 6
Thanksgiving Day (Nov. 24)	Nov. 25



4 CONTAINERS (Or Equivalent) PER WEEK LIMIT

Limit of four (4) 32-gallon containers or the equivalent volume each week. Construction debris may be substituted for one can per week. Yard waste may be substituted but will be counted as part of your limit. No single bag or container may weigh more than forty (40) pounds.

1 BULK ITEM PER WEEK LIMIT

Households are limited to one (1) bulk item per week. **Televisions and computers cannot be placed in the trash.** Bulk items typically will include:

- Sofa or Large Furniture
- Mattresses Must Be Wrapped in Plastic
- Carpet or Rug-Bundled
- Refrigerator *
- Air Conditioner *
- Stove
- Water Heater
- Washing Machine or Dryer
- Water Cooler *
- Freezer *

*ALL BULK ITEMS WITH REFRIGERATION must be certified as Deactivated Free of Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and Hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) as required under Section 608 of the E.P.A. Clean Air Act.



BRUSH & YARD WASTE

Equivalent of 2 bags or 2 cans of brush and yard waste, no more than 40 lbs. each, may be dropped off at the city recycling center, located at 500 Bushkill Drive between the hours of 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. Seasonal evening pickup may also be available by calling 610-250-6680. There is no limit on leaf drop off. No grass clippings will be accepted.

Rules for Disposing of Televisions and Electronic Devices

State law prohibits the disposal of certain covered Electronic devices in residential trash. Trash haulers are legally prohibited from taking these items. Televisions and computer equipment must be disposed of at a certified facility or at a scheduled e-cycling event. Please visit our website for updates and information.

City of Easton Recycling Information

Recycling pickup is now weekly.

\$ Recyclebank Rewards Program.

All residents who are serviced by Raritan Valley Disposal are eligible to earn valuable rewards through Recyclebank® just by recycling. Once per calendar year, after earning 1,000 points, customers are eligible to receive a credit for one month of trash and recycling fees. If you do not yet have a bar code sticker on your city recycling can, please contact the Public Works Department for more information. Acceptable Recycling Materials:

These items may be cleaned and combined together in your Blue City Recycle Can.

- Aluminum foil & cans (beer & soda)
- Glass bottles & jars (food & drink only)
- Plastic bottles, jars, tubs & buckets (soda, water, juice) – no plastic bags
- All plastic food and beverage containers labeled #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 and #7. – no styrofoam
- Metal food cans (tin/steel), metal pots & pans
- Paper – dry & clean (not in plastic bags)
- Newspaper, inserts, magazines & catalogs
- Junk mail, envelopes, file folders
- Office white, colored & computer paper
- Cardboard – broken down no larger than 2 ft. by 2 ft.
- Cereal & gift boxes (remove any bags from boxes)
- Paper cartons for milk or juice (gable-top cartons) or wax coated boxes
- Paper bags & phone books
- Wrapping paper (remove metallic paper, bows, etc.)

Unacceptable Materials:

- Ceramics, dishes, coffee cups, drinking glasses, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs
- Glass cookware/bakeware (Pyrex, etc.)
- Take-out containers, plastic cups, & tableware
- Containers of hazardous or toxic materials
- Tissues or paper towels
- Bound books
- Household appliances or toys
- Coat hangers
- Food waste, garbage
- Styrofoam products or plastic bags



Recycle cans are available for \$5 at Easton City Hall.

Household Hazardous Waste:

Below are some items that may be dropped off at a Northampton County Household Hazardous Waste Event or another certified facility. For dates and times please call 610-559-3000.

- Oil-Based paint
- Thinners
- Batteries
- Motor oil
- Antifreeze
- Drain cleaners
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Tires can be dropped off at a Tire Repair facility.
- Latex paint can be placed curbside once it has dried up. You may add kitty litter, sand, or saw-dust to help speed up the drying process.

Combine cleaned recyclable materials in your blue recycle can.

Place your blue recycle can curbside on your collection day. Collection is now weekly.
